What we will do

Using the information provided, we will:

- trace the National Insurance numbers for your employees
- reply by letter listing only those employees we have been able to find National Insurance numbers for.

If we have been unable to trace a National Insurance number for any of the employees on this form, it may be because we did not have enough information or you supplied an incorrect date of birth. Please resubmit your request for those employees that we failed to trace, with any additional information that you think may help us to trace them.

If your employee does not have a National Insurance number please ask them to contact the Department for Work and Pensions Contact Centre on **0845 600 0643**.

Please note we cannot trace a National Insurance number for anyone under age 16.

How we use your information

HM Revenue & Customs is a Data Controller under the Data Protection Act 1998. We hold information for the purposes specified in our notification to the Information Commissioner, including the assessment and collection of tax and duties, the payment of benefits and the prevention and detection of crime, and may use this information for any of them.

We may get information about you from others, or we may give information to them. If we do, it will only be as the law permits to:

- check the accuracy of information

We may check information we receive about you with what is already in our records. This can include information provided by you, as well as by others, such as other government departments or agencies and overseas tax and customs authorities.
